Did you know that nearly 100% of UC undergraduate students receive financial aid? Every incoming full-time undergraduate student is considered for an academic scholarship upon admission to UC, and those awards are based entirely on the students' GPAs, no standardized test necessary! Because of our strong investment in our students (and our flexible curriculum that allows many students



to graduate in less than four years), UC students graduate with less debt on average than students from many of West Virginia's other universities—including some public institutions! Of course, our institutional generosity is only possible because of the generosity of the alumni and friends of UC/MHC. A significant portion of the scholarship awards we're able to give students based on their exceptional talents and potential for contribution to our campus are funded by you. Whether to honor a distinguished alumnus or a respected faculty member, scholarship monies donated by our alumni help the Admissions and Financial Aid offices build scholarship packages that attract (and retain) the best and brightest to UC. We are thankful to have the capability to enhance our academic scholarship dollars with additional awards that often make the difference in a student's decision to become a Golden Eagle. If you know of an exceptional high school student, encourage them to visit www.ucwv.edu/scholarships for more information on our academic scholarships (up to \$20,000 annually) and our additional scholarship programs including the Presidential Scholarship which provides full tuition, room and board for four years of undergraduate study (application deadline is January 11, 2021).
