Three “mini” ceremonies will be held on April 24th in the Wehrle Arena to maintain a safe, socially distanced experience. Over 300 students plan to attend, each with two visitors. Our commencement speaker will be alumnus and Atlanta Falcons football player John Cominsky. Since December, we have been working closely with the Kanawha Charleston Health

Department on vaccine distribution. Our physician assistant and pharmacy faculty and students have been instrumental in helping West Virginia lead the nation in vaccine access. With most employees already vaccinated, we will be hosting clinics for current UC students, and weekend clinics for the local community (e.g., resident of Kanawha City). We are gratified to live our community involvement mission by combatting the novel coronavirus.

We are excited to launch two new graduate programs in the coming academic year. The new Master of Science in Business Analytics and Applied Artificial Intelligence will launch in Fall 2021. Spring Sports Highlights:

Baseball Coach Britt's baseball team has the best start EVER in program history with an overall record of 17-3, and they are 11-1 in MEC play.

W. Tennis Coach Foote's team is having an impressive season, they have won their last 9 matches and now move to 4-0 in conference matches.

M. Soccer Coach Smee's guys defeated Notre Dame College (2-1) in blizzard conditions last week in Cleveland, Ohio. The team possesses an overall record of 6-0 at this point in time.

W. Golf History was made last week when our women's golf team broke the **school record** for the best ever round of golf being shot (**308**) and finished in 2nd place at their Invitational Tournament, losing by five strokes to Mercyhurst University out of Pennsylvania.

M. Track and W. Track UC Track team has two NCAA qualifiers. Jack Mastandrea competed in the 10k and finished with a time of 29:02.95. With the time, Mastandrea was the top Division II finisher in the event (7th overall) and earned an NCAA Automatic Qualifier on his way to recording his personal best, as well as a new Charleston Track and Field record in the event. Nathan Stout finished 6th overall in the Shot Put and finished as the top Division II finisher in the event. With his throw of 17.22m, Stout earned an NCAA Provisional Qualifier with the 11th best throw in Division II this season.
