The University of Charleston Boat House was the first permanent structure built on the present-day campus. Located above the boat dock on the west end of campus, it opened in 1947 as a cafeteria and snack bar. The porch was later enclosed to become a dining room for faculty and staff. The Boat House served as home to the UC crew team and their equipment.



The Give Day 2021 funds will be used to refurbish the Boat House. The refurbishment will give students an additional recreational outlet on campus and provide the university an additional catering venue.
