On the women's side, Charleston took home their second straight MEC title with a score of 37, taking first with a margin of 33 points over Davis & Elkins.

Men's Golf also gets a MEC championship! As a group, the Golden Eagles combined for a score of 907, 43 strokes over par, and would take home the team trophy for the Mountain East Conference. Charleston combined for a score of 298 on the second round which would end up being the best round of the tournament for any team.




