Summer is also the time when we try to start and complete campus projects. Even though we have about 1,700 students enrolled in courses this summer, the majority are fully engaged online, so it's the best time for physical work to get done. Here are some of the exciting projects underway:

- Completion of the outdoor recreation area at the former Cox Hall site, including new beach volleyball, basketball, and pickleball courts – thank you to all of our generous Give for Gold Day donors!
- Residence hall renovations such as carpeting, bathroom fixtures, furniture reupholstering and replacement, and painting.
- New and renovated classrooms in Clay Tower Building and Riggleman Hall
- For health care students and programs, the new Healthcare Simulation Center in Riggleman Hall including a new nursing station and manikins; for the Physician Assistant program new anatomy tables; new radiology imaging equipment on the 1st floor of Riggleman; new manikins for the School of Pharmacy; and new nursing and Occupational therapy simulation labs in Beckley.
- Relocation of the IT Helpdesk to provide better student accessibility and support
- Creation of a new virtual reality lab that will incorporate 3D imaging in anatomy and physiology, radiology, and other content areas.
- New turf installed at UC Stadium and at the softball field we share with the city.

- Resurfacing of the Riggleman Rotunda patio, and pressure washing all of our buildings.
- And last but not least, complete redesigns of our Student Union dining facilities to expand the number of food stations, offer fresh grab-and-go items and hot beverages, provide pre-ordering of to-go meals, and create expanded student lounge and multi-use space.

These projects will certainly enhance the student, faculty, and staff experiences at UC. And we know you will enjoy them too when you visit campus! We could not undertake these projects without your support.

UC Receives \$1.9 Million in Funding to Create Innovation Hub

The University of Charleston (UC) will be creating the UC Downtown Innovation Hub (DIH) to help small businesses in the Kanawha Valley scale up and grow. The UC DIH co-locates a business coworking space, business accelerator, coaching, advising, employee training, and community event space at the corner of Capitol and Lee Streets in the heart of

Six UC Athletic Teams are now champions! Men's Golf, Men's and Women's Track and Field, Men's and Women's Tennis, and Baseball claimed the MEC Conference title.

This past October, the Men's Golf team earned their title and in May, qualified for the NCAA tournament. They were one of two teams to represent the MEC in the NCAA Division II Men's Golf National Championship.

For Track and Field, the Women's team won their first outdoor championship in school history and the men won their SIXTH consecutive- WOW!.

The Men's Tennis team made it back-to-back MEC Championship titles and advanced to the Sweet Sixteen round of the NCAA tournament for the first time in program history.

Women's Tennis clinched the #1 seed for the MEC tournament and became regularseason co-champions after a 7-0 sweep over West Liberty.

Finally, the Baseball team is back on top of the Mountain East Conference after defeating the Glenville State Pioneers in the championship.
