Items needed include:


- Canned meat or fish (tuna, chicken, salmon, corned beef, slim jims, beef jerky)
- 3 Oatmeal, cereal, granola
- Canned fruits (We have plenty of canned vegetables.)
- Canned soup or stew of a large variety (Maybe something a little more hearty like Progresso or Campbell's Chunky.)

- Shelf stable microwave meals that just require water added (meatloaf and mashed potatoes, macaroni and chili, chicken and dumplings, or macaroni and cheese)
- Canned pasta dinners
- Reanut butter and other shelf-stable dips and spreads (cheese, salsa, or ranch)

- Crackers- any variety to add to soup, used for spreads, or snacks like Cheeze-its

Golden Eagles Soared in Seattle!


