Xavier was an accounting student for three years, graduated in 2014, and then stayed an additional year to help coach the basketball team with Coach Dwaine Osborne. "Coach Osbourne and I remain close. My senior year was his first year coaching at UC and the inaugural year of the Mountain East Conference. That year, we won the MEC conference championship against West Liberty with a buzzerbeater basket (shot by Xavier)! We were the first team in UC history to ever win a MEC title. Nobody can ever take that title, it's not a record that can be beaten. It was the cherry on top of a wonderful three years." "Xavier was instrumental in leading the Golden Eagles as a senior. He did that on the court evidenced by being named an All-American, but he also did it off the court through his leadership influence on everyone within the program, as well as others throughout campus. ### Spirit of the Valley: A Special Recognition of our Board of Trustees Chairman, Patrick Graney, III.



textbooks, class and lab fees, and emergency travel expenses for students in need.


