

Thank you for your generosity and continued support of our students, faculty, and staff.




Ashley Mellert, '16, UC Faculty

"Unlike Syracuse, at UC, I was one of the few identifying indigenous people. Even though there was not an indigenous

community for me to connect with, the lacrosse team was my community.

New Tuition Discount for UC Alumni!

If you are considering a graduate degree, UC now offers a tuition discount for our alumni. The discount is 20% off the published tuition for the selected degree program.

The following UC graduate degrees are eligible for the discount: Master of

Business Administration (MBA), Master of Business and Data Analytics, Master of Science – Strategic Leadership, Master of Science – Cybersecurity, Master of Science in Nursing – Family Nurse Practitioner, Master of Science in Occupational Therapy, Doctor of Executive Leadership (DEL), and Doctorate of Pharmacy.

Students must have earned a degree from the University of Charleston and be admitted to one of the approved graduate degrees to be eligible for the discount. The discount cannot be combined with any other tuition discounts (e.g. military/law enforcement discount, etc.) with the exception of athletic scholarships.

With only one conference loss this season,


Head Coach Luke Reynolds is leading this team to set multiple school records.

MEC Baseball Championships coming to Charleston!

The Mountain East Conference announced an agreement with the City of Charleston, the Charleston Convention and Visitors Bureau, and the Charleston Dirty Birds that will bring the MEC Baseball Championship to GoMart Ballpark beginning in 2023. The agreement extends through 2027. The 2023 MEC Baseball Championship will be held May 10-14.


