The University of Charleston is proud to collaborate with WorkforceWV and other business partners to launch UC Works: a scholarship and work program in which eligible students will utilize a combination of institutional, state, and federal aid programs to cover their UC undergraduate tuition and mandatory fees without out-of-pocket cost or the need to take out student loans. UC Works students will also be matched with a local employer for part-time paid employment during their enrollment at UC.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Students must be admitted as first-time freshman to the University of Charleston (www.ucwv.edu/apply).
2. Students must submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit their results to UC (school code 003818). Students must be eligible for both Pell Grant and WV Higher Education Grant funds.
3. Students must be eligible for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) support through WorkforceWV.
4. Students must be willing to work 20 hours per week during their enrollment at UC with their UC Works partner business.

**Students will be selected for UC Works on a rolling basis until cohort is filled. Apply early for best consideration.*
