UC Alumnus Memorialized in a Special Way

Nancy LeFevre ('74) passed away on January 19, 2023. Nancy gave 47 years of service to Kanawha County Schools as a passionate elementary school educator and served for 50 years on the Board of Directors of Camp Caesar's Physical Education Conference. To honor Nancy, her friends, Kathy Stout and Kathy Houchins, worked with the UC

Advancement Office to create a fundraiser that would benefit current UC education students.

This week, Nancy's friends and family were on campus to pass out physical education equipment kits to UC students. These kits were filled with a variety of physical education equipment and will be used when our education students are in the field for their student teaching experiences.

"Nancy was a wonderful elementary education teacher and always tried to incorporate physical education into her lessons. She would be very proud to know these items have been donated in her name," said Suzy Summers.

ALUMNI Spotlight



Jim Holland, '80

Jim Holland, a native of Dunbar, WV, had a long 30-year tenure working in and around baseball offices throughout southern West Virginia. He is best known for his successful 24-season career (1992-2015) as the General Manager of MLB affiliated Appalachian League professional baseball teams in Princeton, WV. Those 24 seasons in Princeton saw him operating rookie level teams for the Cincinnati Reds five seasons (1992-96) and the Tampa Bay Rays 19 seasons (1997-2015). A total of 84 future major league players were on his Princeton teams during that time.

In 1993, in only his second season at Princeton, he was named the Appalachian League Executive of the

Year for that season. He is still the only person in Appalachian League history to be a five-

time winner of the Appalachian League Award of Promotional Excellence. His career in the pros culminated with him receiving the Appalachian League President's Award in 2015 for his long-term service to the league. He was Corporate Secretary of the Appalachian League from 2002-2012 and a former member of the league's executive committee. He was also named by the Princeton-Mercer County Chamber of Commerce as its 2012 "Citizen of the Year." His other two stops in baseball front office work were during the 1991-92 seasons with the Huntington (WV) Cubs of the Appalachian League plus being Director of Marketing, Sales, and Game Day Operations four seasons (2016-2019) with the West Virginia Miners (located in Beckley, WV) of the summer collegiate Prospect League.

Jim has been honored in two Hall of Fames. He was part of the 2019 induction class for the West Virginia Sports Legends / Artie Museum and, also in 2019, he was selected for the Appalachian League Hall of Fame. In early 2020, Jim announced his upcoming retirement from baseball administration with his final day on the job being May 15, 2020. He is a 1976 graduate of Dunbar (WV) High School, where he was a two-sport letterman. He graduated Cum Laude with a B.A. in Mass Communications from UC in 1980. He was the Sports Editor for the UC student newspaper during his senior school year. Jim now resides in Mercer County, WV with his wife Judy. They are very proud of their son, Warren Hypes, who is Vice President of Creative and Brand for the Tampa Bay Rays in St. Petersburg, FL.

Jim has written a book titled "My Fortunate Detour" and was recently back on campus as the quest speaker for the UC Builder's March Luncheon. The UC Builders was established as the Women Builders by President Leonard Riggleman in 1954. In 1990, the organization welcomed men to its membership and voted to adopt the name University of Charleston Builders. President Marty Roth values the members as builders of the vision and promoters of the image and growth of the University.

The UC Builders have been critical to the continued growth of the University, having donated more than \$400,000 over its history for various projects. Members annual dues fund projects that help improve the quality of life for students. The projects have ranged from intellectual stimulation such as the



purchase of library books and computer software to physical comforts such as the redecoration of the Student Lounge, Frankenberger Art Gallery, the Appalachian Room, as well as scholarships for deserving students, and much more.

This group plans seven luncheon meetings each year, focusing on authors and artists with West Virginia connections. Membership of the UC Builders helps to continue a strong organization that works to uphold the high standards and reputation of the University as well as contribute to the community of Charleston, West Virginia.

Welcome, Coach Leiby!!


