In the morning about 220 undergraduate students will walk across the stage to receive their associate and bachelor's

degrees. U.S. Senator Joe Manchin III will be our commencement speaker. Our afternoon ceremony will include approximately 90 graduate students earning their master and doctoral degrees. The commencement speaker will be UC Assistant Vice President and retired General Dr. John Barnette. I am excited to hear their messages which will surely be insightful and inspiring.

As we shift into the summer terms, we are expecting over 1,600 students will be enrolled in UC classes. Included in this group are over 1,000 active military personnel earning leadership and cybersecurity degrees while serving our country, over 200 students at our Beckley location pursuing healthcare degrees, graduate students in our PA and PharmD programs, and new full-time Charleston undergraduate first-year and rising sophomore Charleston students who are being offered a free course to help them transition to UC and progress toward their degrees.

We hope many of you will take advantage of our <u>20% alumni tuition discount</u> and return for a career-enhancing graduate degree in business or healthcare. This is just another way UC creates value by enabling alumni to attain their personal and professional goals at a lower cost.
