
### **UC School of Leadership**

This film is a true story of Violetta Petrosyan, UC Director of International Students, and her family, forced to flee their Azerbaijan home with only what they could carry during the collapse of the Soviet Union.

Through American missionaries, they sought refuge in the United States, became citizens, and found their home in Charleston, WV. It is a harrowing tale and a testament to love, courage, and faith.

UC and Violetta's church, South Charleston First Church of the Nazarene, offered their communities a chance to see the film by hosting the showing. The movie showing included a red-carpet entrance to the theater, with a display of items depicting the Petrosyan's frightening journey. The evening was complete with a Meet & Greet before the event, and a Q & A session following it.




