Nikki Orcutt currently serves as the Vice President for Mullen Plumbing, Heating and Cooling. Before transitioning into the family business in 2023, Nikki spent eight years as the Account General Manager for IGT (now Brightstar Lottery). In this role, she had primary oversight of all Lottery operations in West Virginia with an array of management responsibilities including system operations, software delivery and system testing, lottery retail sales, retail equipment and network communications, Instant ticket warehousing and distribution, Field Sales and Marketing, Data Center, Call Center, Government Affairs, and three facilities.
