Members of the University of Charleston (UC) Builders serve as ambassadors for the University of Charleston. The organization was first established as the Women Builders by President Leonard Riggleman in 1954. In 1990, the organization welcomed men to its membership and voted to change the name to the University of Charleston Builders. President Marty Roth values the support of the UC Builders in promoting the University's vision and image.

Moreover, the UC Builders has been important to the continued growth of the University, having donated more than \$449,000 since its beginning. This support has taken the form of intellectual stimulation such as library books, improvements to the physical campus, scholarships for deserving students, and much more. Annual dues and donations fund these projects that improve the quality of life for University students.

The UC Builders plans seven member luncheon meetings each year, focusing on authors and artists with West Virginia connections as well as meetings to showcase the University Singers and University students.
